Fire Safes are rated to withstand heat and are available in ratings from 15 minutes in a 500° fire up to 4 hours in a 1625° fire while keeping the interior temperature below 350°. These safes provide minimal burglary protection

Data Disks, Cassettes & CD Storage

Data safes are designed to protect from water, magnetic interference and fire. Various ratings are available depending on the amount of protection needed.

Cash and Valuables

Burglary Safes are available in many sizes and levels of security protection. They are rated by the amount of resistance to penetration they provide. They provide no fire protection.

Burglary & Fire Safes are designed to provide both burglary and fire protection. Most of these types provide 1 hour fire protection and they are available in various levels of burglary protection. There is also a large selection of sizes and interiors to choose from. They are usually the best choice for the home.

In-ground Safes provide good security and fire protection, but require encasement in masonry. They usually are buried in a concrete floor although a form can be built and filled with wire reinforced concrete for above ground installation. In a fire the interior will probably get wet.

Security Boxes provide minimal security for small items.

Deposit Safes have a means of inserting cash into the safe without opening the safe, usually in the form of a slot or hopper. They provide a place for employees to store extra cash without having access to the combination of the safe.

Fire Resistant Files these provide a large amount of space for storage of important papers. These come in various ratings from 1 hour to 2 hour and in 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 drawer configurations.

Vault Doors these are available in both fire rated and/or burglary ratings of many levels. These are ideal for those businesses with large volumes of items to store.
